ECP GRANT ANNOUNCEMENT

"The Bureau is pleased to announce a Request For Proposals for grant funds to encourage the utilization of Extended Care Permit hygienists. Grants will range from \$3,000 to \$15,000 and can be used for a variety of purposes to start or expand an ECP program. Safety net dental clinics, local health departments, and private practice dentists or dental hygienists are eligible to apply. The funds can also be used to create or expand a loan bank of portable equipment for ECP use.

Proposals are due by 5:00PM on October 29, 2010, and awards will be announced on November 12.

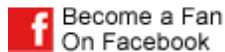
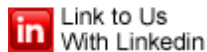
