The Friday conference session featured topics ranging from best practices in rural Kansas dentistry to oral health equity. Keynote speaker Dr. Hugh Silk offered concrete guidance for both medical and dental professionals about how interprofessional integration works in practice.

On Thursday evening at the Delta Dental of Kansas headquarters in Wichita, Karen Finstad was awarded the Excellence in Oral Health Lifetime Achievement Award.

For ten years, Karen Finstad put her heart, soul and considerable energy into improving the oral health of Kansans as executive director of the Delta Dental of Kansas Foundation. Over these years, Karen guided the investment of \$6.6 million involving 111 organizations, serving the oral health needs of millions of Kansans. She worked tirelessly to start many programs, including the Grow Your Own Dentist program that supports and guides young people who are interested in a dental career. Karen also collaborated with Correction Care Solutions (CCS), the United Methodist Health Ministries Fund (UMHMF), The Kansas Association for the Medically Underserved (KAMU) and the Kansas Department of Corrections to start the Dental Laboratory Technician Program. This program teaches inmates how to make dentures for area safety net clinics, allowing them to confidently learn a skill that benefits many underserved individuals.

CMS Oral Health Initiative

We learned last week that the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS) selected Kansas for one of the technical assistance projects related to their oral health initiative. The KanCare program will work with several stakeholders, including Oral Health Kansas, to increase the number of kids on Medicaid and CHIP who receive a preventive dental service and a dental sealant. Through this project, Kansas will receive national technical assistance to develop a plan to achieve that goal. We are thrilled that Kansas was selected.
