## What Can You Do in Two Minutes? Brush!

February is [National Children's Dental Health Month \(NCDHM\)](#) and is brought to you by the American Dental Association and Crest + Oral B. During this month, dental professionals, healthcare providers and educators promote good oral health.

Dental disease causes children to miss more than 51 million school hours each year and parents lose 25 million work hours annually because of kids' oral disease. Prevention and early detection can help avoid these issues.
