CDC's Division of Oral Health Releases Strategic Plan

CDC's Division of Oral Health has released its Strategic Plan for 2011-2014. The Plan was informed by a Strategic Priorities Meeting held last year at the National Oral Health Conference. At that meeting, suggestions were gathered from representatives of 25 national partner organizations on important issues, opportunities, and driving forces relevant to the future of the nation's oral health. The Plan describes the mission, role, core functions, and public health priorities of CDC's oral health program, as well as 8 goals and associated strategic priorities focused on improving the oral health of the nation.

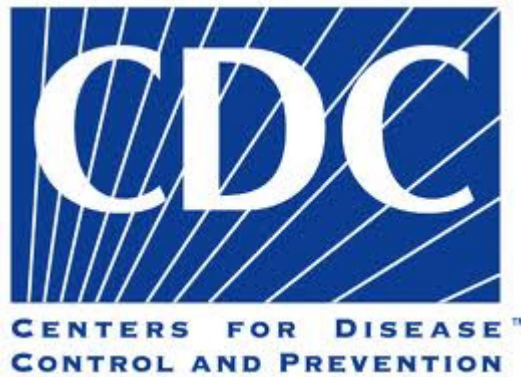

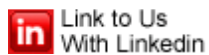


Pew Report Card
