Oral Health Kansas has been sharing regular updates through our Weekly Wednesday Updates. We hope you have found these to be valuable.

We would like to have your input as we plan our update topics for 2013.

A new bill to establish the RDP model was introduced last week in a House Committee. As of this writing, [HB 2157](#) has not been set for a hearing. A similar bill was considered in the House and Senate health committees in 2011 and 2012.

RDPs would be dental hygienists who receive an additional 18 months of training to provide certain dental services, such as fillings, extractions of baby teeth, and extractions of loose permanent teeth. The RDP would work under general or direct supervision of a dentist. To learn more about the model, visit the Kansas Dental Project's [website](#).

**KanCare Regional Meetings Set**

Later this month the state will host a series of 16 regional meetings about KanCare, the state's new Medicaid managed care program. The meetings will focus on how to choose the KanCare plan that is best for you and your family. The meetings will be February 18-21 and will be located in Dodge City, Manhattan, Winfield, Topeka, Garden City, Salina, Parsons, Kansas City, Colby, Great Bend, Fort Scott, Olathe, Hays, Wichita, Emporia and Atchison. **Ombudsman Available to help with  
KanCare Challenges**

To help ensure challenges people encounter with KanCare are addressed, the state has established a [KanCare Ombudsman](#) office. James Bart started work as the Ombudsman in December. He brings a background as a lawyer and a father of a child with a developmental disability. The Ombudsman's office is charged with helping people resolve KanCare service problems, understand their rights and contact the right people to resolve their issues. representatives. All of the elected officials are age 60 or older. The SHL provides an educational experience in the political process and an opportunity to identify policy concerns for Kansas' older adults. The SHL develops bills and resolutions that are presented to the Kansas Legislature and Governor Sam Brownback as recommendations for state policy.

Elected Silver Haired Legislators are responsible for advocating for their legislation, testifying at hearings on SHL legislation, meeting with older adults in their county/district and attending scheduled SHL meetings.

Elections to become a Silver Haired Legislator are set for **March 14**. Candidates must be 60 years or older and registered to vote in their district.

Candidate registration forms and additional information are available on the Kansas Department for Aging and Disability Services [website](#). Forms must be downloaded, signed and returned no later than **Feb. 14 at 4:30 p.m.** Forms and information also are available at Kansas' Area Agencies on Aging (AAA). 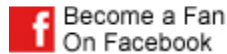
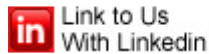
