ADCF acquires, stores, maintains, and transports top-of-the-line dental equipment and the associated expertise necessary to conduct charitable dental clinics across the United States that benefit those in need. Since 2008, ADCF has supported clinics in 31 states which have provided 260,000 patients with nearly \$175 million in charitable oral health care.

"ADCF has been at the heart of the charitable clinic effort in America since 2008, and our 10-year anniversary speaks to our sustainability and commitment to the underserved among us," Blasing said.
